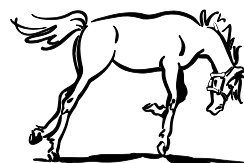

If classes run late and we are running out of daylight, they may be run as only one round, half of which will be timed.

Competitors Please Note: In the interest of equine welfare

For Jumping competitors entering classes in other Rings:

No Horse/Pony may compete in any more than 3 Classes in Ring 5.

For Competitors entering only Classes in Ring 5:

No Horse/Pony may compete in any more than 4 Classes.

HRF Show Rules:

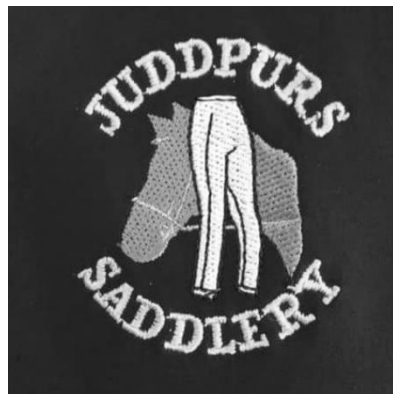
1. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry.
2. Hard hats to current regulation impact standards must be worn, with straps fastened, at all times by those mounted, and are advised in the In-hand classes
3. Proper Footwear with a defined heel must be worn at all times when mounted.
4. The organisers and landowners will not accept liability for any injury, accident, damage or loss caused by or to any person, animal or property, whether competing, attending or otherwise.
5. Horse and Ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in the ridden classes.
6. No child under the age of 3 will be allowed to compete.
7. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
8. Protests or complaints must be made **in writing** within 20 minutes to the chairman or the secretary, with a £20.00 deposit, which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
9. Ages for all competitors and horses are taken as of 1st January 2026.
10. **Litter bins are provided for your use, so please use them, or, preferably, take your litter home with you.**
11. Lorries and trailers must not be mucked out onto the showground.
12. Interference from outside the ring may result in elimination.
13. Disqualification for the day can result from:
 - a. Excessive use of whip or spurs
 - b. Dangerous riding
 - c. Riding a sick or lame animal
 - d. Any breach of the rules
14. **In the interest of safety, it is only permissible to walk your horses and ponies in the trailer lines, trotting and cantering among them is not allowed.**

THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL – Abuse of our Judges, who kindly give their time freely, will not be tolerated and will lead to total disqualification.

***Although we have tried hard to organise the running order as best as possible, some classes may clash. Please notify the ring steward if you are in another ring when your class is called. We will do our utmost to ensure you do not miss your class, but, out of courtesy to the Judges, classes will only be held open for 10 minutes. Once the steward has closed the gate, no more competitors will be allowed into the ring.**
